Re: AM2014/229, AM2014/230, AM2014/224

In accordance with the Directions of 12 May 2016 in these matters, I write to advise that the NTEU's position on the outstanding matters in relation to the exposure drafts remains as reported at the Conference on 10 May.

In relation to the proper expression of the "Doctoral/Subject Coordination" point in the casual academic rates of pay in both AM2014/224 and AM2014/229, we understand that the employer parties were awaiting feedback from their respective members/clients about the subject coordination issue. We have not yet heard anything further from them on that issue.

In relation to the list of employers bound by clauses 5.6(a) and 6 of AM2014/229 and clauses 6.6(b) and (v) of AM2014/230, we note that the AHEIA was asked to provide an updated list.
