In response to the Report and up-date concerning Technical and Drafting Summary and Proposed Substantive Summary associated with the *Electrical, Electronic and Communications Contracting Award 2010*, released on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2017, Fire Protection Association Australia does not seek to make any amendment in the 3 documents. However, and more specifically, there does not appear to be agreement between the parties with respect Items 15A and 48 – dealing with hours of work: day workers and shift workers. In addition, the respective matters dealing with Schedule B as per the revised summary of submissions dated 24<sup>th</sup> April 2017 appear to also lack agreement between the parties. Item 18 (Rest Break) appears to be a matter for dealt with "later if it arises". And so it would seem that at this stage, these and other matters will be ones to be progressed further and as the Commission decides.

Accordingly, subject to further comments of other parties on respective issues they have raised, the above would summarise the current position of Fire Protection Association Australia.
