suffering from 'Saens' Syndrome. He was the eldest of 7 children
He has remained in my care always - over 56 years; his father
died of cancer before [Redacted] was 20 years old. [Redacted] has attended
The [Redacted] Business Service since he was 18 Y.O.
He attends daily and refuses to take any days off. (Has 1900 hours
sick leave). He attends the [Redacted] from 7am -> home
at 4pm each day. The NDIS has not arrived in the area yet.
[Redacted] is illiterate - has No reading or writing ability, and has
poor conversational skills. He would never be considered for
any open-employment. However he has led a good normal life
or as good as can be expected; His attendance at a sheltered
workshop daily has also enabled me and his siblings to live
a better lifestyle as well. The City of [Redacted] has a
high unemployment rate. A sheltered workshop is desperately needed
here to supply an alternative for the disabled seeking employment.

I have been riding my Bicycle to work each day, and am exercising & not sitting around all day. [redacted] Workshops are necessary for the Disabled People like me.
