Pursuant to a decision of the Full Bench on 3 December 2018 in [2018] FWCFB 7350 concerning *Health Professionals and Support Services Award 2010* (Award), and in accordance with issues discussed at Directions Hearings of 22 May 2019 and 23 August 2019, the Fair Work Commission (Commission) makes the following directions:

- 1. By no later than **4pm on** Monday 30 September 2019 Monday 14 October 2019, any interested party is to file submissions, witness statements and other material upon which it seeks to rely in relation to the following matter:
  - a) whether the List of Common Health Professionals contained in Schedule C of the Award should be indicative or exhaustive.
- 2. By no later than **4pm on** Monday 21 October 2019 Monday 11 November 2019, any interested party is to file a response to the material filed pursuant to Point 1 of these Directions above, including any objection to the admission of evidence with reasons.
- 3. If relevant, by no later than **4pm on** Monday 21 October 2019 Monday 11 November **2019** any interested party is to file an application to be represented by a lawyer or paid agent in accordance with s.596 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth).
- 4. By no later than **4pm on** Monday 11 November 2019 Monday 25 November 2019, any interested party is to file a reply to the submissions filed in accordance with Point 2 of the above Directions, including any reply to any objection to the admission of evidence, with reasons.
- 5. If relevant, by no later than **4pm on Monday** 11 November 2019 **Monday** 25 November 2019, any interested party is to file a response to any other party's application to be represented by a lawyer or paid agent in accordance with s.596 of the *Fair Work Act* 2009 (Cth).

- 6. All submissions shall be sent to amod@fwc.gov.au in both Word and PDF format.
- 7. The matter will be heard on **Monday 2 December 2019** at the Fair Work Commission in Sydney.
- 8. Any party seeking to attend the hearings referred to in Point 7 above at a Fair Work Commission Registry other than the Sydney Registry shall make such a request via email to <a href="mailto:chambers.catanzariti.vp@fwc.gov.au">chambers.catanzariti.vp@fwc.gov.au</a>.
- 9. The parties are at liberty to apply to vary these directions.
