Pursuant to a decision of the Full Bench on 3 December 2018 [2018] FWCFB 7350 concerning *Health Professionals and Support Services Award 2010* (Award) the Fair Work Commission (Commission) makes the following directions:

- 1. By no later than **4pm on Wednesday 31 July 2019**, any interested party is to file submissions, witness statements and other material upon which it seeks to rely in relation to the following outstanding matters:
 - a) whether the occupations of Dental Hygienist and Oral Therapist should be covered by the Award; and
 - b) whether the List of Common Health Professionals contained in Schedule C of the Award should be indicative or exhaustive.
- 2. By no later than **4pm on Wednesday 14 August 2019**, any interested party is to file a response to the material filed pursuant to Point 1 of these Directions above, including any objection to the admission of evidence with reasons.
- 3. If relevant, by no later than **4pm on Wednesday 14 August 2019** any interested party is to file an application to be represented by a lawyer or paid agent in accordance with s.596 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth).
- 4. By no later than **4pm on Wednesday 21 August 2019**, any interested party is to file a reply to the submissions filed in accordance pursuant to Point 2 of these Directions above, including any reply to any objection to the admission of evidence, with reasons.
- 5. If relevant, by no later than **4pm on Wednesday 21 August 2019**, any interested party is to file a response to any other party's application to be represented by a lawyer or paid agent in accordance with s.596 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth).
- 6. All submissions shall be sent to amod@fwc.gov.au in both Word and PDF format.

- 7. The matter will be heard on **Monday 2 September and Tuesday 3 September 2019** at the Fair Work Commission in Sydney.
- 8. Any party seeking to attend the hearings referred to in Point 7 above at a Fair Work Commission Registry other than the Sydney Registry shall make such a request via email to chambers.catanzariti.vp@fwc.gov.au.
- 9. The parties are at liberty to apply for further oral submissions or to vary these directions.
