We refer to the following request in an email received from your Associate on 14 September 2018:

The parties are requested to confirm that the casual loading/piecework rate issue and the CEPU's objection to the position in relation to the tool allowance agreed between the other parties, are the only outstanding issues. Confirmation is also sought that the issue in relation to the Hot Work Allowance has also been agreed to. This confirmation is also required by midday on **Thursday 20 September 2018**.

Amongst the award-specific issues that Ai Group has raised concerning the *Sugar Industry Award 2010*, there are no outstanding issues. We understand that the ASMC and AWU will respond separately addressing the status of the hot work allowance issue which has been the subject of discussions between these parties.
