3. By 4:00pm on 14 November 2022, the Construction, Forestry, Maritime, Mining and Energy Union shall file and serve an outline of submissions and any evidence upon which it intends to rely.
4. By 4:00pm on 14 November 2022, any other person who is permitted by the Fair Work Commission to make submissions or adduce evidence, shall file and serve an outline of submissions and any evidence upon which that person intends to rely.
5. By 4:00 pm on 5 December 2022, the Applicant shall file and serve an outline of submissions and evidence in reply upon which he intends to rely.
6. The matter be listed for a hearing of one day on or after 8 December 2022.
