Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:
1. By deleting the amount “\$16.71” appearing in clause 18.3(a)(i) and inserting “\$18.02”.
 2. By deleting the amount “\$93.42” appearing in clause 18.3(b)(i) and inserting “\$116.76”.
 3. By deleting the amount “\$653.57” appearing in clause 18.3(b)(ii) and inserting “\$816.84”.
 4. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:
