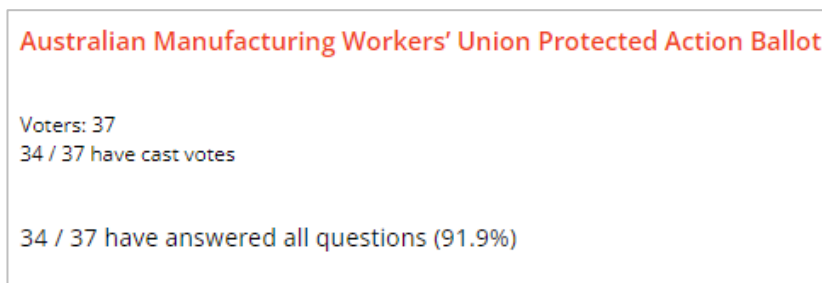
1. Ballot Result

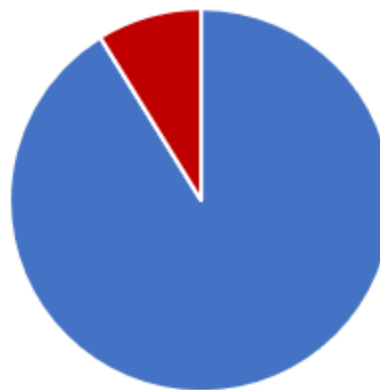

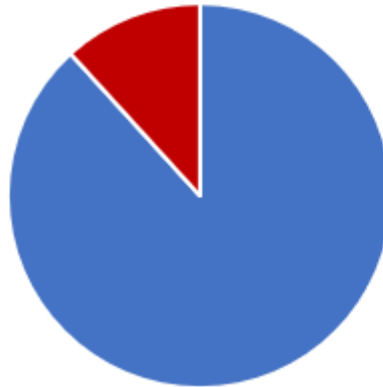

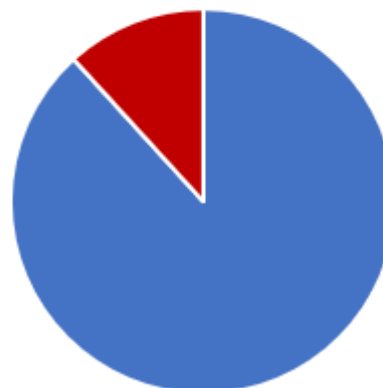

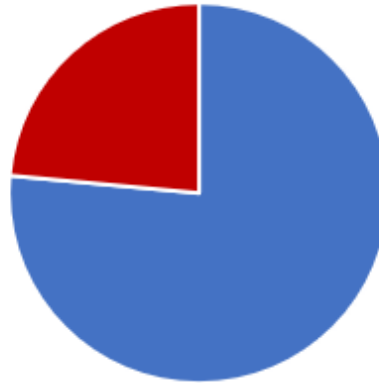

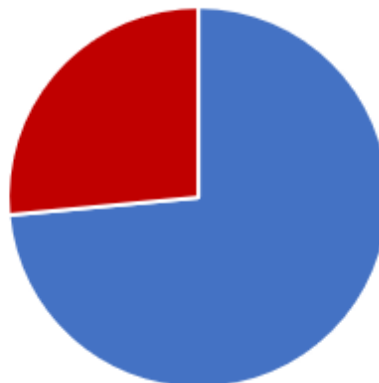

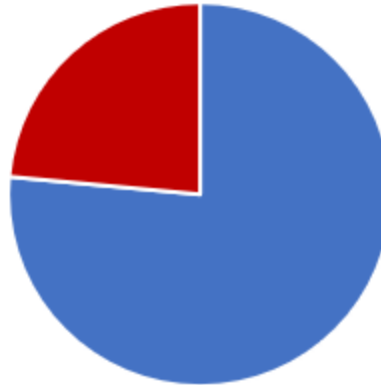

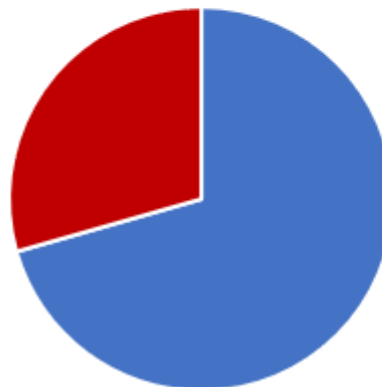

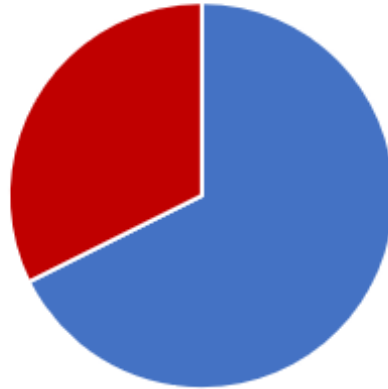

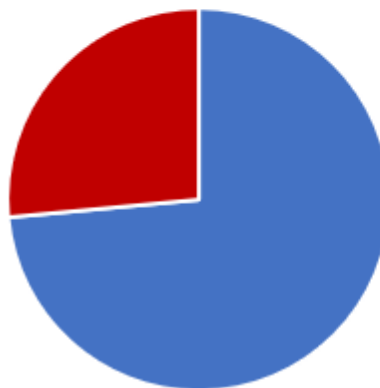

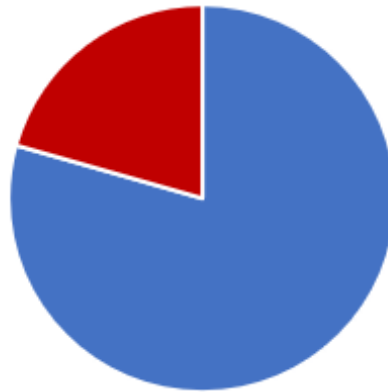

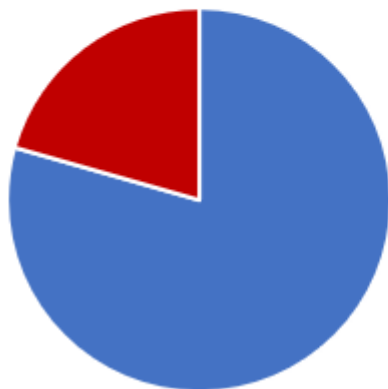

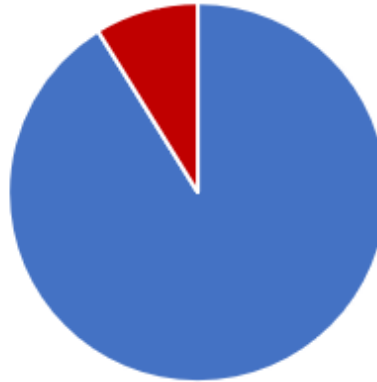

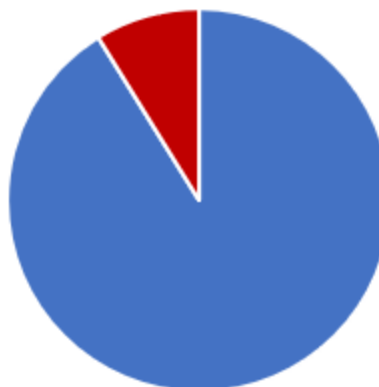

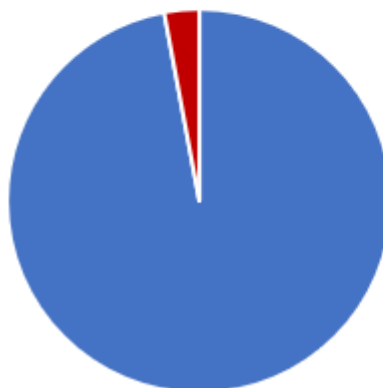

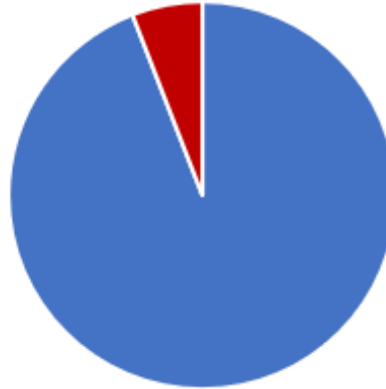

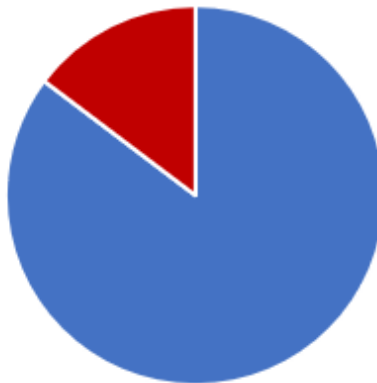
