We note the directions, draft program and updated witness list dated 9 March 2016.

In relation to the *Hospitality Industry (General) Award* 2010 ('Hospitality Award), *Restaurant Industry Award* 2010 ('Restaurants Award') *and Registered and Licenced Clubs Award* 2010 ('Clubs Award') (collectively:'the Hospitality Awards'), there are 2 claims within the part time and casual employment common issue proceedings that are coming up for hearing that United Voice is interested in.

The first is as a respondent to claims concerning variations to the part time work clauses in the Hospitality Award and Restaurant Award made by the Australian Hotels Association and Clubs Australia. The Applicants evidence is being heard during the 12-13 July 2016 hearings. United Voice on 22 February 2016 filed evidence in reply to these matters.

The second matter is an application by United Voice for overtime for casuals under the Hospitality. This claim is listed for the 16 to 17 August hearings.

The evidence in reply to the part time employment claims is listed for hearing in the 16 to 17 August hearings. This material comprises:
