In the Background Paper published by the Commission on 25 July 2017, The AWU proposal to amend the first aid allowance clause at 10.1(c) of the Exposure Draft for the *Pastoral Award 2010* has been incorrectly stated as:

"An employee appointed by their employer to perform first aid as required in addition to their usual duties, and holding a current recognised first aid qualification such as one from St John Ambulance or a similar body, must be paid an allowance of **\$2.63** per day."

The AWU proposal in our submission dated 17 April 2016 is:

"An employee appointed by their employer to perform first aid duty as required in addition to their usual duties, and holding a current recognised first aid qualification such as one from St John Ambulance or a similar body, must be paid an allowance of \$2.63 per day."
