Submissions regarding Decision in [2018] FWCFB 1548 re technical and drafting issues in *Airport Employees Award Exposure Draft*

 The CPSU makes these submissions in accordance with the Decision [2018] FWCFB 1548 of 21 March 2018 which determined the technical and drafting issues in the *Airport Employees Award Exposure Draft*. In that decision the Full Bench asked interested parties to comment on parts of their decision and an updated exposure draft that gave effect to their decision.

Items 1 and 16 – standard rate

2. The CPSU notes the submissions of the AMWU of 13 April 2018 regarding this issue. The CPSU supports the approach outlined at paragraph 5 of those submissions.

Item 3 breaks

- 3. The CPSU notes the submissions of the AMWU of 13 April 2018 regarding this issue. The CPSU supports the approach outlined at item 7 of those submissions where the AMWU have proposed a new inclusion at clause 18.1 to clarify that shiftworkers have paid breaks but day workers have unpaid breaks.
- 4. The CPSU notes the submissions of the AMWU of 13 April 2018 at paragraph 8. That submission draws the Commissions attention to an issue in the Exposure Draft a 20 minute break for shiftworkers. The CPSU agrees with the submissions of the AMWU in this regard.

Item 4 – Minimum wages–Professional Engineers

5. The CPSU notes the decision at [136] and the supports the Commission's provisional view to re-include salary progression provisions from the pre-reform *Airport Employees Award 1999*. Although the CPSU notes the typo in the first word of 19.1(e)(i).

Items 7 and 8 – Reimbursement of air conditioning expenses

6. The CPSU notes the Decision at [145] and the proposal to amend the table in 20.3(f)(ii). The CPSU supports the Commissions preliminary view that this is a required alteration.

Item 13 – Broken leave

7. The CPSU notes the Decision at [157] and agrees with the Commission's preliminary view.

Item 14 – Annual leave loading

8. The CPSU notes the Decision at [160] and supports the Commission's preliminary view that the reference to payment in December in clause 24.11(b)(i) for annual leave loading should be altered.

Item 15 – Rostered day off falling on public holiday

9. The CPSU notes the Decision at [164] and the AMWU submissions of 13 April 2018 on this item at [11]. The CPSU accepts the position that the situation could be clarified by the inclusion of a further sub-clause or amending an existing subclause. The CPSU supports the clarification proposed by the AMWU in this regard.
