 Business SA provides this letter in response to the 25 October Statement regarding the plain language re-drafting of the Hospitality Industry (General) Award 2010.<sup>1</sup>

- 4. Business SA made similar submissions on this topic in relation to the *Restaurant Industry Award* 2017 plain language exposure draft. On 24 October 2017 the Full Bench of the Fair Work Commission issued a decision which determined those submissions.<sup>3</sup>
- 5. In that decision, the Full Bench was not inclined to make Business SA's proposed changes.<sup>4</sup>
- 6. In light of the Full Bench's decision, and the reasons for that decision, we do not wish to press Item 8.
