Re. AM2014/196 & AM2014/197 - 4 yearly review of modern awards - casual employment and part-time employment

We refer to the abovementioned proceedings and the associated Full Bench decision of 5 July 2017.¹

Paragraph 408 of the decision indicates that the awards listed in attachment G to the decision contain no minimum engagement period at all. It also states that the Full Bench has reached a provisional view that they should be varied to include a 2 hour minimum engagement period for causals.

The following awards are listed in attachment G but do in fact provide for a casual minimum engagement/payment:

- Cleaning Services Award 2010 (see clause 24.2)
- Corrections and Detention (Private Sector) Award 2010 (see clause 20.4(a))
- Security Services Industry Award 2010 (see clause 21.2(a)(i)).

The inclusion of these awards in schedule G appears to be an error. They should not be amended as proposed. Should this be contentious we would seek to be heard further in relation to the matter.
