Oxfam Australia, Greenpeace Asia Pacific and Amnesty International Australia have decided to withdraw our applications to alter coverage of the Social, Community, Home Care and Disability Services Industry Award 2010.

We have decided to await the outcomes of the imminent investigation by the Fair Work Ombudsman into supply chains within the charitable sector, that will no doubt look at those that conduct face to face recruitment. This investigation may determine which award is applicable, or may make recommendations for coverage. The outcomes of this investigation will be taken into consideration to whether we make a future application to alter this or another award.

As a group of progressive Australian charities, we remain committed to ensuring that those that work as face to face recruitment agents have consistent, equitable and fair conditions for the vital work that they do.
