### Extension of time granted - amended directions

The Transport Workers' Union sought an extension of time, and Amended Directions dated 20 December 2016 were issued requiring interested parties seeking variation/s to any of the Transport Awards to file a draft determination by 3pm on 21 December 2016, and submissions and evidence relating thereto to be filed by 13 January 2017.

# Dates of filing

The TWU's draft determination was filed on 21 December 2016. The TWU's <u>submissions and some</u> <u>evidence</u> was filed on 19 January 2017. Two further statements, those of Robert Bell and Glen Stutsel were filed on 24 January 2017.
