Submission in response to the proposed variations by Queensland Real Estate Industrial Organisation of Employers RE part time commission-only

Introduction

- 1. REEF SA/NT make this submission in response to the Directions issued by the Full Bench on 12 November 2018.
- 2. This submission is specifically in response to the Queensland Real Estate Industrial Organisation of Employers (QREIOE) draft proposed variation to the Real Estate Industry Award in relation to part-time employment for commission-only employees.

Part-Time Arrangements

- Whilst REEF SA/NT continues to stand by our submission that part-time commission-only employment is a necessary provision of the Award, it cannot support the variations proposed by QREIOE.
- 4. In our view the proposed variation by QREIOE significantly contradicts the purpose of commission-only employment. Commission-only employees are rewarded based on results, not time, and as such the introduction of an hourly rate of pay for part time

commission-only employees would be inconsistent with the purpose of commission-only

employment arrangements.

5. Commission-only employees enjoy a greater level flexibility in their working arrangements

and generally expect or demand a higher rate of commission than a salaried/wage-based

salesperson.

6. QREIOE's proposal of imposing a mandatory record keeping regime and hourly rate of

pay for time worked beyond a part time commission-only employee's contracted hours of

work, diminishes the flexibility enjoyed by commission-only employees and contradicts the

purpose of commission-only employment.

7. To be clear, REEF SA/NT continues to strongly support the existing part time commission-

only arrangements enjoyed by many employers and employees in the industry. However,

we cannot support the draft proposal of QREIOE in its current form.
