- [1] The Regional Express Group of Companies and the Qantas Group will provide their draft of the training bond clause to the other parties on or before **4.00pm on Wednesday 11 December 2019**.
- [2] During the time period identified in [1] above, the parties will have discussions and attempt to reach an agreement in relation to the training bond clause.
- [3] If it appears that an agreement is likely to be reached between the parties, the Regional Express Group of Companies and the Qantas Group will notify the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) and may seek additional time to continue discussions pursuant to [2] above on or before **4.00pm on Wednesday 11 December 2019**.
- [4] In the event that no agreement is reached between the parties, the Regional Express Group of Companies and the Qantas Group will file in the Commission and serve written submissions in support of their draft of the training bond clause by **4.00pm on Wednesday 18 December 2019.**
- [5] In the event that no agreement is reached between the parties, the AFAP and the employer parties will file and serve submissions in reply by 4.00pm on Friday 27 December 2019.
