- b. Work covered by the *Educational Services (Teachers) Award 2020* in a long day care setting, but not including the types of work or work performed in the settings outlined in 1(a)(i) – (viii) above; and
- c. Work performed in the ECEC sector in a long day care setting by including that of a qualified chef or cook – not otherwise covered by the *Childrens Services Award 2010* or the *Educational Services (Teachers) Award 2020*
