## Re: Matter No C2019/5255 (s157 Proceeding)

We write with reference to the proceedings above and in accordance with the Directions contained in the Statement issued by His Honour Justice Ross on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2019<sup>1</sup>. ("the Statement")

We support the previous submissions made on 19 September 2019 by the Association of Professional Engineers, Scientists and Managers, Australia ("APESMA") and wish to add the following;

- 1. The Collieries' Staff and Officials Association ("CSOA") is a division of APESMA representing staff employees who are covered by the Black Coal Mining Industry Award 2010 ("BCMI Award").
- 2. We agree with His Honour that the BCMI Award contains classifications which require an undergraduate degree.
- 3. We support the establishment of a separate Full Bench and review in accordance s157 of the Fair Work Act to review wage rates for the relevant classifications of the BCMI Award.
- 4. We are not seeking the inclusion of the BCMI Award as a priority Award.
