Expense-related allowances.

A. Pursuant to s.157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amount "\$11.69" appearing in clause 18.3(b) and inserting "\$12.05".

2. By deleting the amounts "13.52" and "26.37" appearing in clause 18.3(d)(i) and inserting "14.20" and "27.70" respectively.

3. By deleting the table appearing in clause D.2.1 and inserting the following:
