Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s.157 of the Fair Work Act 2009, the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the amount "\$5.82" appearing in clause 18.3(a) and inserting "\$6.09".
- 2. By deleting the amount "\$17.44" appearing in clause 18.3(b)(i) and inserting "\$17.81".
- 3. By deleting the amount "\$17.44" appearing in clause 18.3(b)(ii) and inserting "\$17.81".
- 4. By deleting the amount "\$17.44" appearing in clause 18.3(b)(iii) and inserting "\$17.81".
- 5. By deleting the amount "\$9.83" appearing in clause 18.3(c)(ii) and inserting "\$10.29".
- 6. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:
