## Annual Wage Review 2021–22 (C2022/1)

### PROVISIONAL TIMETABLE

[1] A provisional timetable for the *Annual Wage Review 2021–22* (2021–22 Review) was proposed in a [Statement](#) on 19 January 2022. This was in response to the [parliamentary sitting calendar](#) issued by the Australian Government that listed the Budget to be handed down on 29 March 2022.

[2] The Australian Council of Trade Unions and the Australian Industry Group supported the provisional timetable. No other submissions were received.

[3] The provisional timetable is now confirmed, subject to any further amendments to the timing of the Budget by the Australian Government.

[4] The timetable for the 2021–22 Review is as follows:
