*Expense-related allowances.*

- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:
1. By deleting the amount “\$16.91” appearing in clause 19.5(b)(i) and inserting “\$18.23”.
  2. By deleting the amount “\$13.54” appearing in clause 19.5(c) and inserting “\$14.60”.
  3. By deleting the amount “\$0.91” appearing in clause 19.6(a)(i) and inserting “\$0.95”.
  4. By deleting the amount “\$0.31” appearing in clause 19.6(a)(ii) and inserting “\$0.32”.
  5. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:
