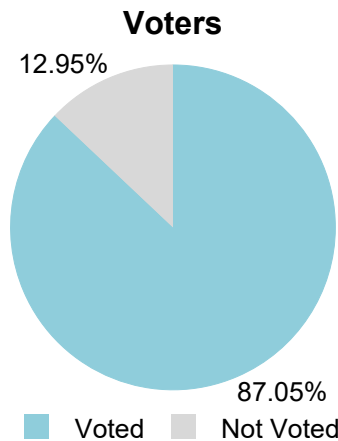

## Ballot Report

The following ballot report is for B2023-80 Protected Action Ballot conducted by TrueVote on behalf of Media Entertainment and Arts Alliance. The ballot was live from 15/2/23 8:00 AM AEDT to 28/2/23 5:00 PM AEDT.

### Voter Roll

The voter roll for the ballot consisted of 942 registered voters. 820 voters responded to the ballot notification sent out by TrueVote.

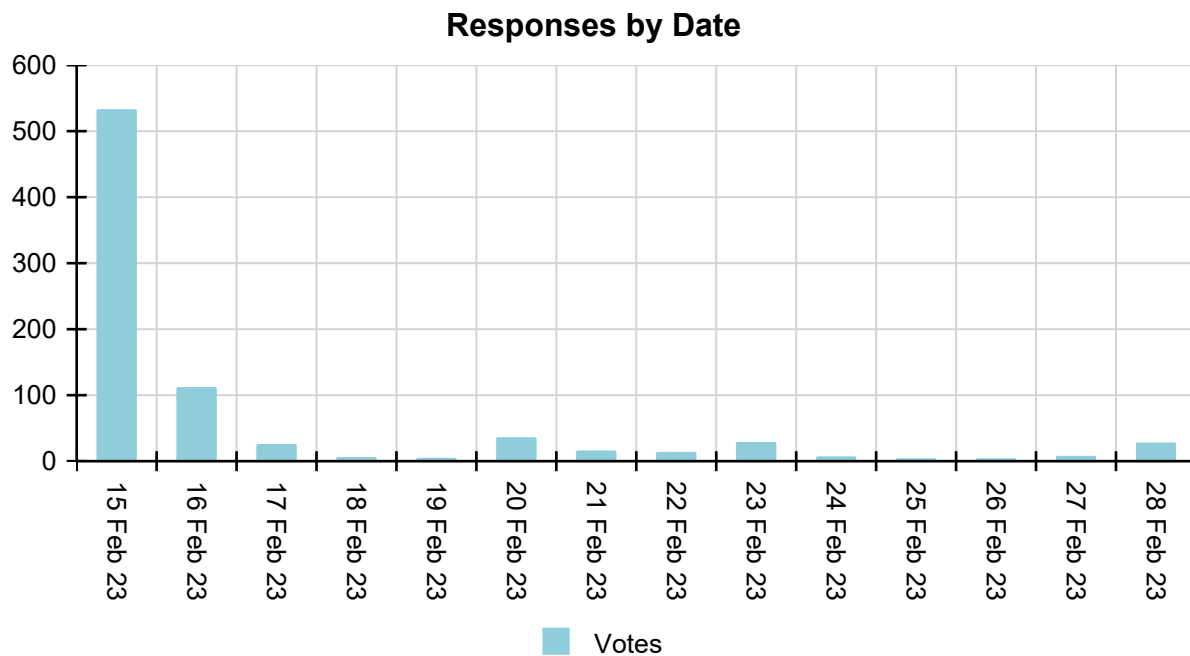
