Modern Awards Review 2023-24 – job security – amended timetable for consultation.

[1] On 7 February 2024, the Commission published a statement outlining the arrangements for the consultation process.

[2] At the first consultation date on 27 February 2024, we concluded the majority of submissions from interested parties relating to questions 6, 7 and 8 regarding job security and standard award clauses. We issue this statement to confirm changed arrangements for consultation as discussed at the conclusion of the first consultation.

[3] The further consultation dates will remain unchanged, but the subject areas will now be as follows:

- Monday 4 March 2024 (in Sydney, with Teams access to be made available) will conclude the rest of the parties' submissions relating to questions 6, 7 and 8 regarding job security and standard award clauses, and will commence parties' submissions relating to questions 4 and 5 regarding casual and part-time employment;
- Thursday 14 March 2024 (in Melbourne, with Teams access to be made available) will continue parties' submissions relating to questions 4 and 5 regarding casual and part-time employment and will commence parties' submissions relating to questions 1, 2 and 3 regarding other provisions in the seven modern awards if time allows; and
- Monday 18 March 2024 (in Sydney, with Teams access to be made available) will conclude parties' submissions relating to questions 1, 2 and 3 regarding other provisions in the seven modern awards.

[4] The notice of listing published on 7 February 2024 will not change.
