### **Opening submissions**

- Parties to make brief opening remarks *summarising* their respective claims and position in relation to claims of others

Tues 4 to Fri 7

**Witness evidence** – unions (one or two days) and employers (one or two days).

Topic based submissions could potentially be commenced in the latter part of this week (depending on who is required, and when)

Mon 10 to Wed 12

### **Topic based submissions**

Example:

#### **WHS allowances**

- MBA makes submissions about claims, relevant evidence
- Others have opportunity to make submission in reply to MBA submissions
- MBA reply

Then on to next topic - **LAFHA**

- CFMEU makes submissions about claims, relevant evidence
- Others have opportunity to make submission in reply to CFMEU submissions
- CFMEU reply

#### **DRAFT ORDER OF TOPIC BASED SUBMISSIONS**

1. MBA WHS Allowance claims
2. CFMEU Living Away from Home claims / MBA+CCF claims
3. Junior Rates
4. Industry Specific Redundancy Scheme
5. TOIL
6. Coverage (both union and employer claims in On-site and Joinery)
7. Hours of Work (including CMFEU claim in relation to casual employment and employer claims) + MBA claims
8. Payment of Wages – frequency, termination, cheque banking,
9. National Training Wage – Civil Traineeships – Standard NTW Schedule
10. Other Allowances claims:
  - a. HIA/MBA/CCF Fares and Travel
  - b. CFMEU communication and special rates allowance
  - c. Rationalisation/consolidation of allowances - various employers
