Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the Fair Work Act 2009, the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the amount "\$14.13" appearing in clause 17.4(a) and inserting "\$15.23".
- 2. By deleting the amount "\$12.76" appearing in clause 17.4(b) and inserting "\$13.76".
- 3. By deleting the amount "\$0.48" appearing in clause 17.8(a) and inserting "\$0.50".
- 4. By deleting the amount "\$0.91" appearing in clause 17.8(b) and inserting "\$0.95".
- 5. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.2.1 and inserting the following:

Allowance	Clause	\$	Payable
Meal allowance—more than one hour's overtime without 24 hours' notice	17.4(a)	15.23	per occasion
Meal allowance—if more than 4 hours' overtime without 24 hours' notice—further allowance	17.4(b)	13.76	per occasion
Special clothing allowance— laundering—full-time employee	17.5(b)(i)	6.25	per week

Allowance	Clause	\$	Payable
Special clothing allowance— laundering—part-time or casual employee	17.5(b)(ii)	1.25	per shift
Motor vehicle allowance—own motor vehicle—engaged primarily for delivery duties	17.8(a)	0.50	per km
Motor vehicle allowance—own motor vehicle—engaged other than primarily for delivery duties	17.8(b)	0.95	per km

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2023. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee's first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2023.
