I direct that:


1. Cambridge Clothing Pty Ltd (Employer) send:

- a) to any employee(s) covered by the *Cambridge Clothing Company Enterprise Agreement 2014* (Agreement) who has been employed since 18 May 2023 a copy of the memo and attachments to which reference is made at [36] of the Form F24C Declaration in relation to termination of an enterprise agreement after the nominal expiry date; and
- b) a copy of these directions and a further update to all employees covered by the Agreement on the status of the application, including that it has been allocated to me to ascertain whether there is any opposition, and that employees will be contacted by my chambers setting out a process by which employees may communicate their views on the application in confidence to me;

by no later than Midday on Thursday, 15 June 2023.

- 2. The Employer shall provide to the Commission:
 - a) a declaration specifying that it has complied with direction [1]; and
 - b) a list of all employees covered by the Agreement and their email contact details; by no later than 5:00pm AEST on Thursday, 15 June 2023.
- 3. Any employee that wishes to express their views on the application will be given an opportunity to do so by no later than 5:00pm AEST on Friday, 23 June 2023, in a manner that will be set out in an email communication to employees sent by my chambers by no later than 5:00pm AEST on Friday, 16 June 2023
- 4. All material should be sent to chambers.gostencnik.dp@fwc.gov.au.

5. The parties are granted liberty to apply to vary these directions.



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
