Fair Work (Transitional Provisions and Consequential Amendments) Act 2009 Sch. 6, Item 9—Variation and termination of certain instruments due to enterprise instrument modernisation process

Termination of enterprise instruments (EM2023/1)

JUSTICE HATCHER, PRESIDENT

SYDNEY, 9 JANUARY 2024

Fair Work (Transitional Provisions and Consequential Amendments) Act 2009 (Cth) Schedule 6 items 4, 6 and 9 – termination of remaining enterprise instruments – applications to make enterprise awards subsequently withdrawn.

[1] On 12 October 2023, I issued a Statement¹ setting out a provisional view that the *CHC Helicopters (Aircrew/Rescue Crew) Award 2002* (CHC Award) and 51 other modernisable instruments listed in Attachment A to the Statement should be terminated. I confirmed my provisional view in a Decision published on 1 November 2023 (November Decision).²

[2] I note that Attachment A to the Statement contained a typographical error and omitted the following two instruments:

- CSL Senior Management Award 1999
- Pharmaceutical General: CSL Award 1998.

[3] Attachment A is a corrected list of modernisable instruments that will be terminated in accordance with the November Decision, including the CHC Award. An order terminating the modernisable instruments as specified in Attachment A will be published along with this Statement.
