4 yearly review of modern awards – transport industry awards – substantive claims.

In relation to the Passenger Vehicle Transportation Award 2010, the Road Transport (Long Distance Operations) Award 2010, the Road Transport and Distribution Award 2010 and the Waste Management Award 2010 (the 'Transport Awards'), the Commission directs as follows:

[1] Any interested party seeking a variation (or variations) to any of the Transport Awards is to file a draft determination specifying the terms of the variation (or variations) sought by <u>3pm on 21 December 2016</u>.

[2] Any interested party seeking a variation (or variations) identified pursuant to the first direction is to file comprehensive written submissions, and any witness evidence and/or documentary material upon which they seek to rely <u>by close of business on 13 January</u> <u>2017</u>.

[3] Any interested party that opposes a variation (or variations) identified pursuant to the first direction is to file comprehensive written submissions and any witness evidence and/or documentary material in reply **by 3pm on 2 March 2017.**

[4] The matter will be listed before a Full Bench for the hearing of evidence on 6 March to 10 March 2017.

[5] The matter will be listed for telephone mention at <u>9.30 am on 3 March 2017</u> to discuss the programming of the hearing referred to in the above direction.

[6] The matter will be listed before a Full Bench for closing submissions on 23 and 24 March 2017

[7] Parties are granted liberty to apply to vary these directions.
