## SUBMISSIONS OF CONSTRUCTION, FORESTRY, MARITIME, MINING AND ENERGY UNION - THE MARITIME UNION OF AUSTRALIA DIVISION

- 1. The Construction, Forestry, Maritime, Mining and Energy Union The Maritime Union of Australia Division (**MUA**) makes these submissions pursuant to the permission of the Full Bench in *Variation of awards on the initiative of the Commission* [2020] FWCFB 1760 (**Statement**) at [125].
- The Statement sets out the provisional view of the Full Bench that model clauses for unpaid pandemic leave<sup>1</sup> and annual leave at half pay<sup>2</sup> be inserted into selected awards.<sup>3</sup> The MUA has an interest in two of those awards:
  - (a) Marine Tourism and Charter Vessels Award 2010; and
  - (b) Professional Diving Industry (Recreational) Award 2010
- 3. The MUA supports the provisional view of the Full Bench that both these awards be varied to include the model clauses for unpaid pandemic leave and annual leave at half pay.
