Application by Professional Golfers Association of Australia Limited to vary the Amusement, Events and Recreation Award 2020 and Registered and Licensed Clubs Award 2020.

- [1] The Commission has received an application from the Professional Golfers Association of Australia Limited (the PGA) to vary the *Registered and Licensed Clubs Award 2020* and the *Amusement, Events and Recreation Award 2020*.
- [2] The application is made under s.160 of the FW Act to remove ambiguity, uncertainty or correct error.
- [3] Specifically, the PGA seek to replace the words 'Golf Trainee' with 'PGA Associate' wherever it appears in both awards, e.g.

2. Definitions

PGA associate Golf trainee means an individual formally undertaking the Professional Golfers Association's Membership Pathway Program, for the purposes of becoming a Full Member of the PGA referred to in clause A.3 of Schedule A — Classification Definitions.

 - 3. The application will be listed for preliminary conference (if necessary) at **10.00am Tuesday 16 March 2021.**
