Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the Fair Work Act 2009, the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the amount "\$18.04" appearing in clause 17.8(b) and inserting "\$19.45".
- 2. By deleting the amount "\$0.91" appearing in clause 17.9(b)(i) and inserting "\$0.95".
- 3. By deleting the amount "\$0.31" appearing in clause 17.9(b)(ii) and inserting "\$0.32".
- 4. By deleting the amounts "\$2.68" and "\$1.36" appearing in clause 21.3(d) and inserting "\$2.80" and "\$1.42" respectively.
- 5. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:
