- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:
1. By deleting the amount “\$15.20” appearing in clause 17.3(a) and inserting “\$16.20”.
  2. By deleting the amount “\$5.92” appearing in clause 17.3(b) and inserting “\$6.06”.
  3. By deleting the amount “\$0.96” appearing in clause 17.3(e)(iii) and inserting “\$0.99”.
  4. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.2.1 and inserting the following:
