- A. Further to the decision issued by the Expert Panel in the Annual Wage Review 2022–23 on 2 June 2023 [[2023] FWCFB 3500], the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the table appearing in clause 8.4 and inserting the following

- 2. By deleting the amount "\$4.65" appearing in clause 9.8(a) and inserting "\$4.92".
- 3. By deleting the amount "\$3.27" appearing in clause 9.8(b) and inserting "\$3.46".
- 4. By deleting the amount "\$0.74" appearing in clause 9.8(c) and inserting "\$0.78".

5. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.1 and inserting the following:

Language skills allowance - Grade 2	per hour	18.45	4.92
Language skills allowance - Grade 3	per hour	12.3	3.46
Language skills allowance - Grade 4	per hour	2.53	0.78
