Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the Fair Work Act 2009, the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the amount "\$0.91" appearing in clause 18.3(a) and inserting "\$0.95".
- 2. By deleting the amount "\$15.50" appearing in clause 18.3(b)(i) and inserting "\$16.71".
- 3. By deleting the amount "\$15.50" appearing in clause 18.3(1)(ii) and inserting "\$16.71".
- 4. By deleting the amounts "\$487.91" and "\$488.19" appearing in clause 18.3(1)(iii) and inserting "\$609.80" and "\$610.15" respectively.
- 5. By deleting the table appearing in clause E.2.1 and inserting the following:

Meal allowance—overtime	18.3(b)(i)	16.71	per meal
Travel board and lodging—meals	18.3(l)(ii)	16.71	per meal

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2023. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee's first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2023.
