*Expense-related allowances.*

- A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:
1. By deleting the amount “\$14.40” appearing in clause 21.2(a) and inserting “\$15.30”.
  2. By deleting the amount “\$14.40” appearing in clause 21.2(b) and inserting “\$15.30”.
  3. By deleting the amounts “\$1.93” and “\$9.46” appearing in clause 21.4(a) and inserting “\$1.98” and “\$9.72” respectively.
  4. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:
