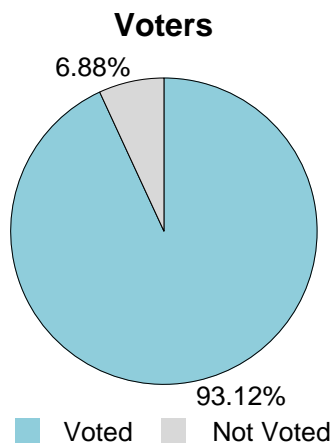

The following ballot report is for B2022/537 Protected Action Ballot conducted by TrueVote on behalf of Australian Federation of Air Pilots. The ballot was live from 15/6/22 12:00 PM to 22/6/22 12:00 PM.
