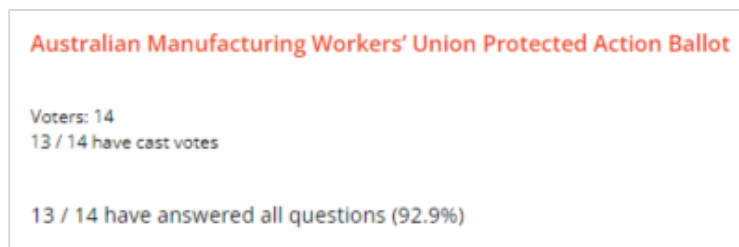
1. Ballot Result

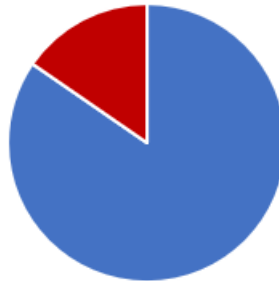
Question 1

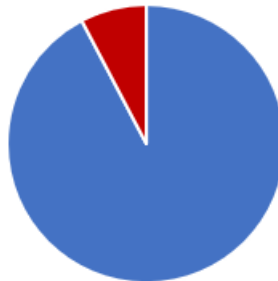

■ No - 1 (8%)



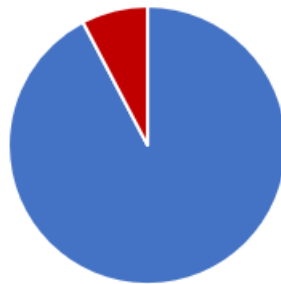
Question 5
