Dear AMOD

We refer to this matter, and to the draft determination published with respect to the *Hospitality Industry (General) Award 2020* (**HIGA**).

In its decision [2021] FWCFB 5371 the Commission determined to insert Appendix J and K into the HIGA, dealing with loaded rates.

At [58] of the decision, the Commission said:

"Finally, we turn to the proposition that the loaded rates will need to be 'recalibrated' in the event that there is an increase in the quantum of the split shift allowance following an Annual Wage Review decision. Commissioner Bissett will convene a conference of all interested parties following the publication of the 2021-22 Annual Wage Review decision to discuss whether the loaded rates require adjustment to ensure that employees are not worse off."

We note that the draft determination recently published by the Commission makes no adjustment to the loaded rates percentages in Appendix J.

We respectfully request the Commission convene a conference of interested parties at its convenience, to discuss this matter, prior to the finalisation of the draft determination.
