#### Dear Ms Venal

I refer to the above proceedings and to the Full Bench's request for proposals to make awards easier to use by 22 December 2023.

ABI and BNSW complied with the directions. However, we were made aware late last week of a discrete issue affecting the *General Retail Award 2020* (**GRIA**) which appears to fall within the scope and purpose of these proceedings.

Specifically, there are divergent views in relation to clauses 15.7-15.9 of the GRIA and to whom the clauses apply. In particular, we are aware that there are differing views regarding whether the clauses apply to casual employees or not. These divergent views were partially identified in *Award flexibility-General Retail Industry Award 2020* [2021] FWCFB 3571 at [54]:

[54] NANA submits that rostering requirements in clause 15.9, which it believes do not apply to casual employees, should be amended to explicitly articulate where a sub-clause applies to full-time employees and when it applies to both full-time and part-time employees.[38] The SDA opposes this change and does not agree that casuals are never part of a roster.

However, the issue was not clarified as part of those proceedings.

There continue to be differing views expressed to ABI/BNSW in relation to whether clauses 15.7-15.9 of the GRIA apply to casuals. ABI and BNSW support the position of NANA outlined above and, in particular consider that there are practical impediments to clause 15.9 applying to casual employees.

## Request to include clause in consultation sessions

We appreciate that this issue has been raised late in the proceedings. However, given that:

- clarifying this issue would make the GRIA easier to use (which is the purpose of these proceedings);
- the issue is a discrete one; and
- reply submissions are not due until 19 February 2024,

we respectfully request that the consideration of the application of clauses 15.7-15.9 be included in the GRIA consultations.

Should the Commission be open to considering this issue, ABI would be willing to promptly file a draft determination to confirm its position regarding the clauses, should this be of assistance.
