**4 Yearly Review of Modern Awards
(AM2014/196 & AM2014/197) Part-time employment and Casual employment
Casual Conversion – Timber Industry Award 2010**


We refer to the correspondence (20 September 2018) previously filed by the CFMMEU – Manufacturing Division ('CFMMEU – MD') regarding an anomaly in the casual conversion provision of the Timber Industry Award 2010 ('*Timber Award*').

Since that time, the Casual employment and Part-time employment Full Bench has issued a number of decisions, including on 21 September 2019¹ and 2 April 2019².

In the latter decision, the Full Bench stated, in part, at paragraph [1] that '*There remain three issues outstanding in these proceedings...*' with reference to the *Stevedoring Industry Award 2010*, the *Horticulture Award 2010* and the *Education Services (Post-Secondary Education) Award 2010* [emphasis given].

To date, the matters raised by the CFMMEU – MD in its September 2018 correspondence have not been considered by the Full Bench or otherwise listed for a Conference or Directions. We again we raise this issue to ensure that the *Timber Award* issue is appropriately dealt with prior to the finalisation of the overall proceedings.
