We write in relation to the Direction from Deputy President Bull on 15 March 2016 that parties provide an update regarding the status of Issues 72 to 77 in the Full Bench Report regarding the 4 yearly review of the *Storage Services and Wholesale Award 2010*.

The AWU's understanding about the status of these matters is:

- <u>Issue 72</u>: In accordance with the joint union submission dated 22 January 2016, we maintain that the wording in clause 6.2 of the Exposure Draft should be amended to read: "A full-time employee is an employee engaged to work an average of 38 ordinary hours per week". The AIG has not agreed to this wording;
- <u>Issue 73</u>: There is no agreement on this issue. The unions rely on their submissions dated 22 January 2016;
- <u>Issue 74</u>: This matter has been withdrawn as per the AWU's email to Chambers on 19 January 2016;
- <u>Issue 75</u>: An in principle agreement has been reached between the unions and AIG to resolve this issue. We expect the AIG will shortly provide amended wording;
- <u>Issue 76</u>: There is no agreement on this issue. The unions rely on their submissions dated 22 January 2016; and
- <u>Issue 77</u>: An in principle agreement has been reached between the unions and AIG for this claim to be withdrawn.
