NATSIHWA seeks the insertion of the Definitions in order to give effect to NATSIHWA's proposed variations to the coverage and classification clauses of the Award (as set out in NATSIHWA's Amended Draft Determination dated 1 June 2017).

NATSIHWA's claims for variation to the coverage and classification clauses of the Award has been referred to the Full Bench of the Fair Work Commission for determination. Accordingly, we respectfully submit that the Definitions should not be inserted into the Revised Exposure Draft until the Full Bench has determined NATSIHWA's claims for variation of the coverage and classification clauses of the Award.

## References to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander

We confirm that the Fair Work Commission has requested confirmation from the parties as to the use of the term 'Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander'.

In accordance with [24] of the Decision [2018] FWCFB 1548, we confirm that all references to 'Aboriginal' should be replaced with 'Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander'.
