Dear Mr Crawford,

On 27 January 2017, the AWU made a <u>submission</u> in relation to the Sporting Organisations Award as follows:

Clause 8.2 of the SOA provides that ordinary hours for coaching staff are provided by the NES (38 hours in accordance with section 62), however clause 13.1 excludes coaching staff from the overtime provisions. This exemption is clearly incompatible with clause 8.2 and appears to exclude the operation of section 62 of the FW Act. For this reason, we propose to remove clause 13.1 as follows:

Clause 13 only applies to Clerical and Administrative staff

It does not appear the AWU has filed any further submissions in relation to this claim.
