**Re: AM2014/249 Wine Industry Award 2010**

1. We refer to the matter above and the Directions of 14 December 2016 and in particular Directions 1 (i) and (ii) – parties are directed to confirm which if any technical and drafting claims are still being pursued or otherwise withdrawn.
2. The AWU continues to pursue all our claims in regards to the *Wine Industry Award* that remain outstanding as reflected in the items set out in the Commission's Revised Summary of Submissions republished 26 July 2016. These items are as follows:
  - 2.1. Items pursued by the AWU and agreed to or otherwise not opposed by other involved parties: 18, 22, 25, 29, 30, 31, 32, 34 and 37.
  - 2.2. Items pursued by the AWU but opposed by one or more involved parties: 35, 49, 53, 62 and 72.
  - 2.3. Items opposed by the AWU: 7, 8, 9, 10, 14, 16, 36, 50, 52, 54 and 59.
3. We confirm our position regarding Item 72, and endorse the addition and content of the table at B.2.3 of the Exposure Draft republished 29 July 2016.
