## **Submission to the Fair Work Commission: Response to applications for orders filed by AED Legal Centre for the production of documents - AM2014/286.**

NDS has received advice from the Fair Work Commission in respect of the application for draft orders from AED Legal Centre in matter AM2014/286, review of the SES Award 2010.

Following clarification from the Commission and in order to prevent any further delay, NDS provides this response to the application on behalf of its membership in order to meet the original deadline of 7 September 2017.

NDS opposes the applications for the orders sought by AED Legal. The application seeks detailed information from NDS members that is either already publicly available, or relates to wage assessment tools identified in the SES Award that are no longer in use.

NDS is of the view that AED legal can obtain the information sought in their application without the need for the Commission to request such information from our membership at this stage of the SES Award review process.
