Dear Associate

We write in relation to the above matter, and refer to Tuesday's Full Bench decision in 4 yearly review of modern awards – Overtime for casuals [2020] FWCFB 4350.

In our view, the application of the relevant principles in this decision, and the wording proposed by the Full Bench in the resulting Draft Determination, are relevant to matters currently before the Full Bench in AM2020/25. Noting that submissions have now closed in AM2020/25, we bring this to the Deputy President's attention to enquire as to whether the Full Bench wish to be addressed by the parties on this matter.

We have raised these views with both the other unions and the employer groups involved in this matter to date. Neither the AI Group or the CMIEG support the CFMMEU in bringing this matter to the Full Bench's attention, and it is our understanding that they consider it would be inappropriate for further submissions to be made as the "Yallourn/Domain approach" is not new, and that it has already been accepted that there would be no opportunity to file further submissions in the current proceedings. We can confirm that the other union parties do not object to the CFMMEU bringing this decision to the attention of the Full Bench.
