**4 YEARLY REVIEW OF MODERN AWARDS — CONCRETE PRODUCTS AWARD
2010 (AM2014/70)**

We refer to the report-back hearing held before Vice President Hatcher on 15 May 2017 in this proceeding, and the Directions issued on 15 May 2017 as a result of that report-back hearing (“**Directions**”).

Further to those apologies conveyed on 15 May 2017, we confirm our sincere apologies for any inconvenience caused to the Commission and the other parties by our failure to appear at the report-back hearing.

We confirm that we act for Brickworks Pty Ltd (“**Brickworks**”) and the Concrete Masonry Association of Australia (“**CMAA**”).

We note that the CMAA is the peak body that represents the concrete masonry manufacturers of Australia, including manufacturers of bricks, blocks, pavers and retaining walls.

Whilst Brickworks is the initiating applicant in the application for substantive amendments to the *Concrete Products Award 2010* as part of the Four Yearly Review, Brickworks’ application is supported by the CMAA, and as such is an application from the industry as a whole.


In those circumstances, we would need to seek instructions from both Brickworks and liaise with the entire industry in order to provide the advice required by direction 1 of the Directions.

Accordingly, we are instructed by Brickworks to respectfully request a further 7 days from this Friday 19 May 2017 (being to 5.00pm on Friday 26 May 2017) for the purpose of liaising with the entire industry in order to advise the Commission whether Brickworks and the CMAA wish to proceed with the award variations identified in the submissions dated 7 May 2015.
